BUDGET HEARING

The hearing on the proposed 2017 budget for the Town of St. Croix Falls was called to order by Chairperson James H. Beistle at 7:00 p.m. on November 16, 2016. Proper notice was given as notice was posted in the three designated locations of the Town Hall, Super America, Wayne's Cafe and Lamperts on October 26, 2016; and published in the Inter-County Leader on October 26, 2016. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. Seven electors of the Town were present at the hearing including the chair. Also present were town clerk Janet Krueger and attorney Gary Bakke.

The chair presented the proposed 2017 budget as recommended by the Town Board on October 17, 2016. Reviewed were the highway budget, expenditure budget, and the revenue budget.

The Chair closed the budget hearing at 7:20 p.m.

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

A special Town meeting was called to order at 7:20 p.m. by Town Chairperson James H. Beistle on November 16, 2016. The clerk read the call of the meeting. No poll list was created as the electors present of the Town were known to all.

Sharon Kelly moved, seconded by Nancy Beck, to adopt Resolution 2016-01TM approving the 2016 tax levy in the amount of \$384,306.00; **motion carried** on a unanimous voice vote.

There being no other items to be considered, Frank Behning moved, seconded by Sharon Kelly, to adjourn the Special Town meeting; motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 7:24 p.m.
