

SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING, September 11, 2018

A special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of St. Croix Falls was called to order by Chairman Frank Behning at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 11, 2018, at 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Proper notice was given as the agenda was posted at the town hall and on the town's website on September 7, 2018. A moment of silence was taken in remembrance of 9/11. Present by roll call were Chairman Frank Behning, supervisors Katie Appel, Sharon Kelly and Gary Koecher. Supervisor Mike Dorsey arrived at 6:10 pm. Also present were town clerk Janet Krueger, public works employee Steve Jacobs and Scott Geddes. Kelly/Koecher **moved** to approve the agenda; **motion carried**.

170<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 200<sup>th</sup> Street west .76 miles to hammerhead was walked and inspected.

Appel/Kelly **moved** to have Schultz excavating ditch and berm the south side of the road to the east of the driveway culvert; add straw blanket to the steep edge on the south side of the road; and add six additional rolls of straw blankets to the west end of the big hill on the north side with any remaining blanket to be added where needed; **motion carried** on a unanimous roll-call vote, 5-0.

There being no further business, Kelly/Koecher **moved** to adjourn the meeting; **motion carried** and the meeting was adjourned at 7:32 p.m.
